There was a special town board meeting for the public held at the Owen D. Young School auditorium on April 30, 2024 to give opinions, recommendations, and questions regarding the moratorium.

Special Counsel Bernard Melewski and Town Attorney Gerard Snyder were there to answer any questions. Also attached is a listing of the people who attended.

Also information from each person that wanted to speak was transcribed.

Public meeting was closed at 7:30 pm. Supervisor Bronner proposed a motion to adopt the local law moratorium for the town of Stark. Councilman Hubiak seconded the motion. Roll call of votes. All approved.

Special Counsel Melewski made a brief announcement. Anticipation of the final environmental statement should be by the end of the month. There won't be any action taken or possible action to be taken by the town board at the May meeting and that the town board would take action in June. Reason being for the continued extension was that there have been some modifications to the project. One is the westerly turbine has been moved which was requested by the town of Springfield so it creates a cascading series of adjustments for all the consultants to be done. All material has to be reviewed by Lobella Engineering which is a consultant to the town and special counsel so everything is in proper form before it's published. For the May meeting the town board is reaching out to have someone from New Leaf Energy to attend. The meeting for May 14, 2024 will be at the Owen D. School auditorium.
